

Pickup Truck Bed Extension Invented by InventHelp Inventor (AVZ-1540)

InventHelp, founded in 1984 in Pittsburgh, is attempting to submit this idea, the EXTEND A BED to applicable companies for their consideration.

Fortunately, an inventor from Wharton, Texas, figured out how to solve that problem whether the load is needed for a home improvement project or a professional job.

He developed a prototype for the patent-pending EXTEND A BED to enlarge the size and cargo capacity of a pickup truck bed. As such, it allows the user to transport loads too long for a standard pickup truck bed, like siding and lumber. It, therefore, eliminates the need to attach and tow a trailer to carry an extra-long load. Aside from saving time and effort, it is also safe and easy to install and use. In addition, this innovative pickup truck accessory is convenient, effective and affordably priced.

The inventor's personal experience inspired the idea. "When I had a load to haul that was too long to fit in the standard truck bed, it was such a hassle having to attach and tow a trailer. It's so much easier just to use my truck for this type of situation," he said.
