

## **Frost Prevention Accessory Invented for Interior Car Windows (SUU-390)**

FROST FREE is designed to greatly reduce the buildup of moisture until the defroster is warm enough to do its job. Fortunately, an inventor from St. Louis, Mo., has come up with a strategy that eliminates the need to manually wipe off the excess moisture to see clearly.

He developed the patent-pending FROST FREE to prevent condensation from building up and freezing on the inside of car windows in cold weather. As such, it keeps moisture from the driver's breath away from the windows. Thus, it enhances driving visibility and improves highway safety. Furthermore, it is comfortable, durable and practical. At the same time, it is lightweight and easy to wear and operate. Other appealing features include convenience, effectiveness and an affordable price. Also, the heat of your breath going inside of the coat will help to keep you warmer than without the FROST FREE.

The inventor's concern for road safety inspired the idea. "Since winter temperatures and road conditions present challenges for drivers with regard to visibility," he said, "I wanted to find a way to keep the inside of car windows clear of frost."
