

Inventor Develops Privacy Screen for Emergency Responders (HUN-483)

InventHelp, founded in 1984 in Pittsburgh, is attempting to submit this idea, No Show, to applicable companies for their consideration.

PITTSBURGH, PA (PRWEB) December 16, 2017 -- PITTSBURGH..."My sister is an EMT, and my brother-in-law is a paramedic," said an inventor from Houston, Texas. "In listening to their stories, it became apparent to me that they needed something to shield victims and emergency personnel at the scene of the accident."

He developed the NO SHOW to create a portable barrier at the scene of an accident. This protects the privacy of the victim of emergency situations from the public. It also keeps the public from seeing graphic and gruesome scenes. The barrier safeguards emergency personnel from road debris while attending to and saving injured people. It cuts down on passing motorists "rubbernecking" at the accident scene. Additionally, the unit is designed to be lightweight, easily portable, and quick and easy to set up and take down.

The original design was submitted to the Houston office of InventHelp. It is currently available for licensing or sale to manufacturers or marketers.
