

InventHelp Inventors Develop Mobile Device Vehicle Safety System (NJD-1408)

InventHelp, founded in 1984 in Pittsburgh, is attempting to submit this idea, the TAKE CONTROL to applicable companies for their consideration.

PITTSBURGH ([PRWEB](#)) December 06, 2017 -- Inventors from Toms River, N.J., have developed the TAKE CONTROL, an electronic safety system designed to prohibit texting and talking on a cellular phone while driving a motor vehicle. This system helps drivers safely manipulate their vehicles in traffic without the distraction of accepting and making calls or text messages from a mobile phone.

"We were inspired to create this because of personal experience. The road has become a dangerous place because of careless drivers too occupied with their mobile devices. We wanted to help prevent unnecessary accidents from occurring," said the inventors. The TAKE CONTROL prohibits cellular telephone use by drivers. It eliminates the distraction of holding a phone or looking down to type on a touch screen and allows drivers to stay focused on the roadway ahead. This system may provide peace of mind for concerned parents and business owners. Ultimately, this safety system creates a safer overall driving environment.

The original design was submitted to the New Jersey office of InventHelp. It is currently available for licensing or sale to manufacturers or marketers.
