NM 409 (Bottomless Lakes Road) Pavement Rehabilitation Work to begin Monday, August 14th

Roswell – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Two will begin a project to improve nearly 4.5 miles of NM 409 (Bottomless Lakes Road) in Chaves County.

The project is expected to improve road surface and extend the life of the roadway. Work will begin Monday, August 14th and is expected to be complete in one week, weather permitting.

Work will take place Monday thru Friday, 8:00am to 5:00pm. Message boards and detour signs will be in place to direct motorists and keep vehicles moving safely.
