This can increase premiums by as little as 6%, whereas the cost of making a claim on your own policy can add as much as 23% - so it's a small price to pay for peace of mind.

"For younger drivers, insurance can be expensive however we'd strongly recommend not putting off getting your own policy, but to take steps to make insurance as affordable as possible.
