Spectator seating will open at the special time of 3:00 p.m., with time trial qualifying starting at 5:15 p.m. The first race of the evening is set for 6:15 p.m., while the TRIMSPA 150 is scheduled to take the green flag at 8:00 p.m. Advance tickets are available by calling the speedway hotline at 732-681-6400. Speed Channel® will tape the action for broadcast on Saturday, November 20th.
