Hmiel is no stranger to Phoenix International Speedway. He raced there in the NASCAR Busch® Series during his rookie season but unfortunately fell victim to an early on-track incident that kept him from finishing the race.

“I’m looking forward to hopping back into the TRIMSPA Chevrolet Silverado,” Hmiel said. “I’ve raced at Phoenix in the Busch Series a few years back but was involved in a crash early in the race. I’m looking forward to seeing how the truck will handle on the track. It has fast straights and tight corners. The Phoenix track features ‘two groove’ racing, which allows for easier passing. I know the guys from Billy Ballew Motorsports will have an excellent truck with enough horsepower under the hood to get us up front. We are focused on racing to get into the top-10 in points. We only have a few races left and I need to pick up as many points as possible for Team TRIMSPA and Billy Ballew Motorsports.”

Hmiel will again be playing double duty this weekend by also racing the No. X32 TRIMSPA Dodge® in the NASCAR Busch Series.

Friday’s Chevy Silverado 150 NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series race can be seen live on Speed Channel at 5:30 p.m. eastern. Saturday’s NASCAR Bush Series Bashas® Supermarket 200 will be televised live at 3:30 p.m. on NBC®. Both races can be heard on radio stations affiliated with MRN® and on XM Satellite Radio Channel 144.
