At the core of the TM8110 is a state-of-the-art Digital Signal Processor which optimises Radio Frequency performance and allows integrators to customise installations, for example by altering receiver bandwidth, tailoring audio performance in the transmit & receive path, implementing custom data modem formats in its internal software modem and generating tones for signalling purposes. The configurability provided in the TX and RX paths by the DSP ensures that maximum performance for systems using external modems can be assured.

Flexibility for customisation was a key goal for the designers of the TM8110, multiple ports for auxiliary connectors and a large options board space within the chassis simplify the design of peripherals. The built in modem's serial control and Automatic Vehicle Location (AVL) engine support make the TM8110 a solid base for today's Taxi systems. A comprehensive 3DK developer's kit for the radio provides support documentation and boards to speed the implementation of custom solutions.
