Cash, Cashier's Check and Visa, MasterCard, Discover Card or American Express are accepted at most auction locations. To participate in the auction, you must register to bid prior to each sale. Bidders must be at least 18 years of age with valid I.D. Registration to participate in any Government Auto Auction is free. Previews of the vehicles for auction take place prior to the action sale.
