

## **Petroleum Equipment Institute Announces Online Learning Center**

Petroleum Equipment Institute will previewed a new system that will offer owner-operators of petroleum storage tanks online traing.

Seattle, WA (<u>PRWEB</u>) March 17, 2005 -- The Petroleum Equipment Institute introduced a new online training tool to the regulatory community today. The association plans to roll out the "PEI Learning Center" later this year to offer end-user training on the underground storage systems and components used in most modern filling stations.

The PEI Learning Center will debut in Summer 2005 with five initial courses covering leak detection and spill containment equipment. Eventually, it will offer a comprehensive collection of courses specifically geared to help owners and operators understand their underground petroleum storage systems.

The Internet-based system was demonstrated for underground storage tank regulators and inspectors from across the nation during the 17th annual UST/LUST National Conference. The conference is sponsored by the EPA Office of Underground Storage Tanks, New England Interstate Water Pollution Control Commission, the Association of State and Territorial Solid Waste Management Officials and the Washington State Department of Ecology.

According to EPA there are currently more than 670,000 underground storage tanks in the United States.
