- The future of Social Security: DeFazio will address the financial challenges of Social Security, his plan to strengthen the popular program and what he sees as the $\hat{A} \square pitfalls$ of privatization. $\hat{A} \square$
- Rebuilding roads and bridges: As ranking member of the House Surface Transportation Subcommittee, DeFazio says he will have a unique opportunity to direct millions of federal dollars in road and bridge construction to Oregon $\hat{A}\Box$ vital resources for a state struggling with a \$4 billion backlog of bridge repair and road construction.
- Affordable Northwest hydropower: As co-chair of the bipartisan Northwest Energy Caucus, DeFazio will discuss his efforts to $\hat{A} \Box$ combat continued attempts $\hat{A} \Box$ by President Bush $\hat{A} \Box$ to gouge Oregonians and dismantle affordable, efficient hydropower in the Northwest. $\hat{A} \Box$

DeFazio is also a member of the Transportation and Infrastructure Committee, and serves as ranking member of the Aviation Subcommittee, where he is a vocal advocate for consumers and aviation security. He also serves as a member of the Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation Subcommittee and the Railroad Subcommittee.

He says he has logged over two million miles traveling between Oregon and Washington, DC about three times each month to serve the people of Oregon's Fourth Congressional District in the United States Congress.
