The T3 Cradles and No Sway Cages are included with all higher end hitch bike rack models and available as an optional upgrade on most others.

General Manager of Sales and Operations, Shawn Standen, said "We are particularly excited about this years' line up of hitch bicycle racks from Thule. The new stablizing features of the cradles signify a new level of bicycle stability previously unavailable to our customers. The fact that this is integrated into the cradles also means there are far fewer steps necessary in loading up bikes and hitting the road. Previously the Thule Zip Stick accessory was necessary to secure the bikes to the carrier. This meant not only additional cost for another accessory but also more steps involved in the loading process." Mr. Standen further explained, "The T3 Cradles are much more friendly in accomodating virtually all bike frames including kids bikes, womens bikes, bmx and downhill mountain bike frames. This also eliminates the need for the Thule Top Tube Adapter, another accessory that is offered at additional cost allowing non-traditional bicycle frames to work with hitch bicycle carriers."
