

Motor Along to Hutton-in-the-Forest's Historic Vehicle Show

More than 300 classic vehicles including Victorian bicycles and a 1936 Standard Avon Special Sports Saloon designed for Edward VIII will be gathering next month at Cumbria's Hutton-in-the-Forest.

([PRWEB](#)) May 28, 2005 -- More than 300 classic vehicles including Victorian bicycles and a 1936 Standard Avon Special Sports Saloon designed for Edward VIII will be gathering next month at Hutton-in-the-Forest.

The annual Hutton-in-the-Forest Historic Vehicle Show takes place at the home of Lord and Lady Inglewood on Sunday 19th June 2005 from 10am to 4pm. Vintage, agricultural vehicles and classic commercials will be joining favourites like Mark II Ford Cortina's, Triumph Stags and MG's galore.

One of the highlights of this rally is a 1936 Standard Avon Special Sports Saloon which was designed for Edward VIII, but used by George VI when Edward abdicated. This immaculate Standard is now owned by Carlisle's David Cleminson and was part of the royal fleet at Sandringham until 1965. It is the only one of this specific design in the UK.

Two of the quirkiest exhibits are early Victorian bicycles - A velocipedes and a boneshaker. A predecessor of the bicycle, the velocipedes has no pedals and is pushed along by foot whilst sitting. The boneshaker dates from 1870 - Its nickname graphically exposes that it was a pretty uncomfortable ride!

Mark Woodward of Woodward Automotives, the Show's organiser, said, "This year's event will be especially accessible because it is being held on the lawns directly in front of the house, rather than on the show field. There are lots of unusual vehicles to enjoy as well as the gardens, parkland and tea rooms of Hutton-in-the-Forest. Hutton is one of those houses which is neatly tucked away in the northern lakes, but is really quite stunning."

Around 3,000 visitors are expected at the Hutton-in-the-Forest Historic Vehicle Show which is one of 18 events being organised by Woodward Automotives during 2005.
