Our children are our future."

By donating the custom chopper to BACA the Iron Angels hope to raise over one million dollars to make America's streets safe for children. The Twenty-dollar raffle ticket is offered as a tax-deductible donation to Bikers Against Child Abuse, Inc, a tax-exempt 501 (C) (3) corporation.

BACA was founded by J. P. Lilly, a Certified Child Therapist specializing in battered and abused children, to create a safer environment for children of high risk. BACA exists as a body of Bikers to empower children to not feel afraid of the world in which they live and ready to lend support to those in need by involving them with an established, united organization. They work in conjunction with local and state officials who are already in place to protect children. BACA sends a clear message to all involved with the abused child that this child is part of their organization, and that they are prepared to lend physical and emotional support to them by affiliation, and physical presence.
