(PRWEB) July 6, 2005 -- For the Castle Combe event Adam would again qualify the car for Sunday's race (Part of the Championship rules for 'A' Class drivers is they must start Sunday's race) "We were struggling in free practice, but then we found a few things not quite right with the car and both myself and Phil Burton were 1.5 seconds quicker than we had been."

Adam finished his qualifying session in the teams best British GT position of 4th "It was great to back at the front of the field, and I didn't even get a clear lap, the car has the pace it should now after finding a problem."

For Saturday's race Phil Burton would start, and drove for around 25 minutes before handing the car over to Adam, who managed to get the Vision Marketing Ferrari up to 7th place at the flag.

Sunday's race would see Adam take the start, and he managed to gain a position on the opening lap and running in a strong 3rd place before the safety car was deployed due to an accident, Adam came into to pit and handed the car over to Phil Burton who rejoined in 7th place and was able to move up the order to 5th by the end of the race.

"Now we have fixed the problems with the cars speed, I am really looking forward to Silverstone as I won the race last year and I am hoping we can achieve just that this time round too," Commented Adam.

The next round is on the 13/14th August at Silverstone.
