

Brad Baker Beats Jared Mees To Win Eddie Mulder's West Coast Dirt Track Series 2016

Brad Baker wins Eddie Mulder's West Coast Dirt Track Series' main event, beats out Jared Mees at biggest race of the series yet at Willow Springs International Raceway, CA.

Mulder is a lifelong motorcyclist who began his life's work as a pro flat tracker when he won the 1959 Mojave Hare Scramble at the age of 16, at which he famously beat Bud Ekins. He soon went on to become the first racer to win the AMA's Grand National Triple Crown, the Ascot TT, Castle Rock TT, and Peoria TT, before beginning his transition into becoming a successful Hollywood stuntman, during which he would do work for such icons as Clint Eastwood. Even in his 70s, Mulder's passion continues to thrive as he won the legendary Pikes Peak International Hillclimb a staggering eight times. Mulder recently became a part of British Customs' Legends Series honoring the true greats of motorcycling that helped shape the foundation of today's global motorcycle culture. The Legends Series unites past with present by allowing riders to honor their culture's rich heritage and carry it forward by personalizing their modern classic motorcycles with parts designed in collaboration with legends like Eddie Mulder and Sonny Nutter, including the British Customs Drag Pipes and Slash Cut TT Exhaust.

Mulder continues to give back to the community which he has already dedicated so much to by putting on the <u>Eddie Mulder's West Coast Dirt Track Series</u> (EMWCDTS) every year. The EMWCDTS is a private, prestigious flat track event held annually at Willow Springs International Raceway in Southern California. Only the best racers step out onto the grid, and to win among them at the EMWCDTS is a true honor.

"There were true gunslingers out there on the grid this year," Mulder said about this year's race. "We had some real racing this weekend that made me proud to put on this event."

This year's EMWCDTS was held on October 1st and 2nd at Willow Springs International Raceway, and the main event had a \$10,000 purse. Brad Baker beat out rival Jared Mees in a true battle of skill to win this year's main event and take home the winner's purse. Flat track fans know of the perennial battle between the two racers and of the intriguing announcement that they, with Bryan Smith, will be racing together on Indian's "Wrecking Crew" team on Indian's new racing-only FTR750.
