

Caravan of Limos to Deliver Toys to Schneider's Children's Hospital

At that time Santa and his helpers from the Association will present the toys to representatives of the hospital. Toys will later be given to children who are patients at the hospital and unable to go home for the holidays.

"We have been collecting toys for several weeks and we are very pleased by the support of our members and friends," said Matt Silver, owner of Ultimate Class Limousine and Caravan of Toys coordinator.
