

## Bozell Steps Up to ASA Late Model Series Northern Division: Western Michigan Veteran, Jeff Bozell to Step into the ASA Late Model Series Northern Division for Glasstree Racing in 2006

Portage, Michigan veteran, Jeff Bozell has announced his intentions on running the full slate of events in the ASALMS Northern Division for the 2006 season. Kalamazoo, Michigan based Glasstree Racing, Bozell's car owners, also announced that Bozell will drive the familiar Bozell Family #83 for the 2006 season.

Returning drivers, new teams, and old friends are planning their 2006 seasons around the ASALMS in any and/or all three of the traveling series' within the Series.

Bozell has made one career start in the ASALMS back during the USPRO Cup Series days in 2003. The 23-year veteran made the most of his one start in the series as he led all 50 laps of the Wesley Clark 50 at his home track of the Kalamazoo (MI) Speedway on September 20, 2003, to score the feature win. Bozell was driving the potent Troutt-Hitchens Machine that went to victory lane three times with three different drivers that season.

"We had a lot of fun in our one race in USPRO Cup." Stated Bozell. "For 2006, we're looking to do something different from the local short tracks and the ASA Late Model Series is definitely the way to go. The series is very affordable and extremely competitive. We're looking forward to it." He added.

The ASALMS Northern Division has his home track of Kalamazoo on the schedule and Bozell can't wait for that show. "Oh man that race at the "zoo" is the one we can't wait for! It's in our backyard in front of our home town fans. It's where the whole family grew up." Added Bozell. "We've all got that show marked down on the calender, that whole weekend is going to be fun, Kalamazoo on Friday and Berlin on Saturday for the Michigan Doubles." He ended.

After a year of development with Jeff Bozell as Crew Chief for the Glasstree Racing's ARCA Remax Series team, Bozell is getting the bump to the driver's seat. "We are honored and excited to have Jeff racing with us this year", Says Team Owner Marcus Anthonsen, "Jeff's a guy who knows how to make things happen in a race car, he finds ways to get to the front of the pack."

In 2005 under Bozell, the ARCA Team finished in 14th at Michigan International Speedway after starting 28th and an 11th place finish at Chicagoland (IL) Speedway, after starting 30th. Both events were with driver, Larry Hollenbeck. On top of running the ARCA team, Jeff raced seven events at the Kalamazoo (MI) Speedway in a Limited Late Model and won three features while finishing 26th in the points standings in those limited



## appearances.

Over his career, the 39-year-old Bozell has recorded an impressive 67 feature wins since beginning his driving career in 1982 in various divisions and at various tracks in the state of Michigan and Indiana. Although he's never won a track championship, Jeff has finished runner-up an amazing five different times in the Super Late Models division at Kalamazoo. All to his older brother, nine-time Kalamazoo Speedway Super Late Model Track Champion, and Kalamazoo Legend, Andy Bozell.

Andy has won eight of those titles consecutively since 1998 and is also the 2004 NASCAR Heartland Regional Champion. Jeff's nephews are aspiring driver's in their own right, Phil Bozell, Andy's son, has seen time in the ARCA Remax Series and Andy Bozell Jr., who started his career in 2005 in Kalamazoo Speedway's Pure Stocks division.

In 2006, Jeff Bozell will bring his 23 years of experience to the ASA Late Model Series and is expected to be one of the top contenders for the inaugural 2006 ASALMS Northern Division Series Championship. In addition to the Northern Division, Bozell will run in at least two of the televised Challenge Division events. The first will be at the Berlin (MI) Raceway on Wednesday June 14, 2006. The second date will be during the 2006 Governor's Cup Weekend at the Milwaukee Mile!
