They can even configure alerts to be sent to them whenever road incidents occur or safety deficiencies are detected. Video clips can be automatically recorded, and are accessible from anywhere. These clips and trip data can be used to train drivers, assist investigations, address violations of safety procedures or exonerate the company and the driver when they are not at fault for an accident.

Configurable alerts can aso redirect driver attention to the road and reduce the likelihood of distracted- or drowsy-driver incidents. Meanwhile, training departments can use real-world examples to develop more relevant ways to inculcate a safety culture. Lastly, fleet managers and owners can demonstrate safe practices to customers and insurers. All of this translates to greater safety and reduced risks for company drivers and the driving public at large.
