TNT Super Series dedicates St Thomas double header to the memory of Tim Thorne with \$1000/win on Saturday


Racer barbeque Saturday night!

"We'll be taking donations for the Heart & Stroke Foundation in Tim's memory," said Joe Boniferro, TNTSS title sponsor. "Tim was very well known around here and had a significant impact on the local racing community."

This past year has been exceptionally tough on the southern Ontario drag racing community also losing Gene Emes, Gerald Anderson and most recently Jim Moore.

Along with the barbeque, there will be goodie bags from Permatex and Performance Improvements for the first 35 racers. "This weekend is going to be a lot of fun," added Ted. "It's going to be a real celebration in memory of Tim."

In addition to the two TNTSS races this weekend, the series will also finish an event from May 21st that still has six cars remaining.

Gates open Friday for weekend camping. Open time trials at 10am Saturday, qualifying at noon with eliminations to follow. Sunday will also include the regular St Thomas Raceway Park bracket classes.
