About Crew Chief Richie Wauters: Starting at the tracks around Green Bay, WI Richie Wauters quickly moved into the NASCAR Touring Series. Wauters crewed successful NASCAR Nationwide Series teams with Rusty Wallace and Johnny Sauter. Wauters, who has worked for Billy Ballew Motorsports for the past ten years, led the team to its first victory in 2004 and has continued to lead as the team scored nine more victories during the 2005-2008 NASCAR Camping World Truck Series seasons. Wauters set up the first truck race that NSCS Driver Kyle Busch ran in the Camping World Truck at the Lowes Motor Speedway where he won that event. In his off time Wauters still focuses on racing with his Late Model team. The team won the Snow Ball Derby in 2004 and finished second in 2005. His NASCAR Southeast Series team has nine wins over two seasons. The team won the Southeastern Elite Division Championship and won the last race of the Elite Division at the Phoenix International Raceway at the end of 2006. Wauters has worked with drivers such as; Rusty and Steven Wallace, Kyle Busch, John Andretti, Jeremy Mayfield, Paul Menard, Denny Hamlin, Shane Sieg, Brian Ickler and a host of other top NASCAR drivers.

Ickler makes First Start at Monster Mile for Ballew

Brian Ickler will take to the track for his second start at Dover International Speedway but first start in the NASCAR Camping World Truck Series Friday, May 29, 2009. Ickler will pilot the No. 15 Samsung Instinct Billy Ballew Motorsports Toyota Tundra in the AAA Insurance 200 race on the one-mile track.

Ickler sat on the pole in the NASCAR Camping World East Series race at what has been named the "Monster Mile" at Dover International Speedway in 2008. Ickler led nine laps but was involved in an incident on lap 26 putting the car out of the event early.

"I'm excited about going to a track I've had some laps on," Ickler said. "Despite having gotten involved in an accident I felt I had a pretty good feel for the one-mile concrete track. Our sponsor, Samsung Instinct is holding a contest with several winners receiving tickets to the Camping World Truck Series event at Dover with two lucky winners as part of our pit crew for the race. We'll just follow our instincts in Dover to see if we can get a good finish for Samsung and the fans."

Billy Ballew Motorsports has 10 previous starts at Dover International Speedway with one win posted by Kyle Busch in 2005. Samsung Instinct will serve as the primary sponsor for the No. 15 Billy Ballew Motorsports entry.
