The United States Charges that:


On or about July 22, 2014, within the Eastern District of Missouri,

THOMAS CARROLL,


while acting under color of law in his capacity as a police officer with the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department, willfully deprived M.W., an arrestee in police custody, of his Fourth Amendment right, protected and secured by the United States Constitution, not to be subjected to unreasonable seizures, which includes the right to be free from the use of unreasonable force by a law enforcement officer. This offense resulted in bodily injury to M.W.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 242.


