State Transportation Commission to Meet in Silver City

Santa Fe – The State Transportation Commission will hold its monthly meeting on Thursday, October 18 at 1:30 p.m. at the Grant County Administration Building, 1400 Highway 180 East in Silver City.

The commission was created by state statute as an independent board to determine all matters of policy for the New Mexico Department of Transportation.

Items on Thursday's agenda include:

- 2012-2013 Local Government Road Fund
- Authorizing the resolution to increase from \$40,000,000 to \$50,000,000 and to amend, the State Transportation Third Taxable Line of Credit
- Commission Policy 6, Role and Responsibilities of the Secretary of Transportation

The meeting is also an opportunity for area residents to discuss transportation needs and projects with New Mexico Department of Transportation officials. Time will be allotted for public comment.
