State Transportation Commission To Meet In Albuquerque

Santa Fe – The governor-appointed commission that determines policy for the New Mexico Department of Transportation will meet February 21 in Albuquerque. The six member State Transportation Commission meets monthly to get updates from the NMDOT on its activities and how the commission and the department can enhance our state's transportation system.

The public meeting will be held at 1:30 p.m. at The Mid-Region Council of Governments building located at 809 Copper Avenue, NW.

Items on the agenda include:

- Presentations by Bernalillo County officials concerning transportation needs from a county perspective. Albuquerque authorities will also speak about local transportation priorities and coordination opportunities.
- A report on NMDOT District 3 (Bernalillo, Valencia and portions of Sandoval counties)
- State personnel update from Gene Mosher, Director of the State Personnel Office
