Roswell Native Selected NMDOT District Engineer for Southeastern New Mexico

Roswell - The New Mexico Department of Transportation has selected Roswell native Ralph Meeks, PE as District Two Engineer for the Southeastern region of the state. Ralph was selected this week by Cabinet Secretary Tom Church.

Ralph brings twenty plus years of experience to the position and received an undergraduate degree in civil engineering in 1990 from New Mexico State University. He will be leading all aspects of business management, construction, maintenance and engineering for the district. Several construction and maintenance projects in the District Two region will begin over the next few months.

District Two is the largest of the six NMDOT districts, and serves a population of about 340,000 and includes the highways of U.S 70, U.S. 285, U.S. 380, U.S. 54, U.S. 62/180 and several other routes in Southeastern New Mexico. Its boundaries include Chaves, Eddy, Lea, Lincoln, Otero, Roosevelt, De Baca, Curry, and the southern part of Torrance and Guadalupe counties. It also includes the Southeastern Regional Planning Organization (SERPO).
