
Project Announces Temporary Relocation of Southbound I-25 Off-Ramp Near Ellison

Ramp is being relocated north so crews can widen southbound I-25. Motorists should be prepared to exit new off-ramp sooner.

ALBUQUERQUE – The New Mexico Department of Transportation has announced that the I-25 off-ramp near Ellison will be temporarily been relocated to the north as of 5 a.m. Tuesday, March 18 (see maps below).



The relocation is necessary so that crews can widen southbound I-25 and will be in place for the next several weeks. The only difference that motorists will notice is that they will need to be prepared to exit

southbound I-25 just past Masthead instead of halfway between Masthead and Ellison.

The Paseo Del Norte/I-25 Interchange Reconstruction Project is a project of the New Mexico Department of Transportation in partnership with the Federal Highway Administration, City of Albuquerque and Bernalillo County and in cooperation with the Mid-Region Council of Governments.
