Project Announces New Lane Configuration for Eastbound and Westbound Paseo Del Norte Near Jefferson


Traffic Shifted to North to Allow Work on New Eastbound Lanes of Paseo Del Norte and Paseo Del Norte/Jefferson Street Interchange

ALBUQUERQUE – The New Mexico Department of Transportation has announced that as of Monday, Feb. 24, 2014 commuters will be shifted to a new lane configuration near the intersection of Paseo Del Norte and Jefferson. There will be two lanes of traffic in each direction, but traffic will be shifted to the north side of the roadway so that crews can work on the permanent eastbound lanes and the interchange of Jefferson and Paseo Del Norte.

Traffic will be allowed to turn right, left or continue straight through all directions at the intersection of Paseo Del Norte and Jefferson, but commuters should allow extra time to reach their destinations during the first week of the new lane configuration, expect delays, and/or seek an alternate route. This lane configuration is expected to be in place through fall 2014.



The \$93 million Paseo Del Norte/I-25 Interchange Reconstruction Project is a project of the New Mexico Department of Transportation in partnership with the Federal Highway Administration, City of Albuquerque and Bernalillo County and in cooperation with the Mid-Region Council of Governments.
