I-25 East Frontage Road Pavement Preservation Work To Begin August 25

Santa Fe—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin pavement preservation work on the I-25 East Frontage Road from NM 599 to the Waldo Canyon Interchange on August 25, 2014. This cold mix recycled asphalt pavement preservation work is a remixing overlay process.

Motorists can expect minor delays Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. There will be a one lane closure with a flagger and pilot car operation escort through the work zone. There is NO work scheduled on Labor Day Weekend Saturday, August 30 through Monday, September 1, 2014. NMDOT thanks you for your patience during this pavement preservation improvement project.

The pavement preservation project is scheduled for completion end of September 2014. Brasier Asphalt Inc. is the subcontractor for this project doing work for the prime contractor, Holy Frontier Inc. of Albuquerque.

Drivers are urged to proceed with caution through the work zone, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road advisory website www.nmroads.com
