I-40 Edgewood Interchange (Exit 189) Bridge Improvement Work

Moriarty—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin bridge rehabilitation work at the I-40 Edgewood Interchange (Exit 189) in Edgewood on Monday, October 6, 2014. The bridge improvement work will consist of removing and replacing the bridge approaches, bridge epoxy overlay, new ITS system and miscellaneous median work.

Starting Monday, October 6, motorists can expect minor delays. The I-40 eastbound and westbound lanes will be reduced to one lane at mile marker 189. The lane closures will remain in effect until November 2014.

The Federal Highway Administration and NMDOT have partnered to fund the improvements. The project is scheduled for completion November of 2014; weather permitting. IHC Construction of Albuquerque is the contractor for this project.

Drivers are urged to proceed with caution through the work zone, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road advisory website www.nmroads.com
