I-25/Missouri Bridge – Project Update

Las Cruces – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District One office along with FNF Construction continue with work along I-25 between Lohman Avenue (exit 3) and University Avenue (exit 1). The work currently being performed will impact motorists along Missouri Ave., Don Roser Ave., and Triviz Ave.

The contractor continues with the construction of the I-25 southbound bridge where motorists will encounter lane and width restrictions. The contractor is scheduled to have a closure for the eastbound lanes on Missouri Ave. Wednesday evening May 6th at 8:30 p.m. through 6:00 a.m. on Thursday May 7th. The contractor will need to place a large crane at the intersection of Missouri Ave. and Triviz Ave. that will require the eastbound lanes of Missouri Ave. to be closed as crews work on setting the abutment forms for the bridge. Traffic control and detour signage will be posted throughout the work zone. Intermittent lane closures will continue for Triviz Drive, Don Roser, and Missouri Ave. during weekly operations Monday through Friday.
