

## **Rahal to Greet Racing Fans at Woodlake Market on Thursday Night**

*Popular IndyCar driver to appear in Village of Kohler prior to KOHLER Grand Prix*

Kohler, Wis. ([PRWEB](#)) June 21, 2016 -- Graham Rahal, one of the most popular and well-known drivers in the Verizon IndyCar Series, will greet fans at Woodlake Market – 795 Woodlake Road, Kohler, Wis. – on June 23 from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Rahal will be signing autographs and welcoming fans to view a replica of the IndyCar he drove in this year's Indianapolis 500. Rahal is in the area with his Rahal Letterman Lanigan (RLL) team as they prepare for the upcoming KOHLER Grand Prix at Road America, June 23-26.

Graham is the youngest race winner in IndyCar history as well as the youngest ever Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) champion. He enjoyed his best season to date in 2015 when he was a championship contender entering the season-finale ranked a career-best second place prior to the double-points race at Sonoma Raceway. Contact from another driver led to an 18th place finish and he ended the 2015 season with a career-best season-ending rank of fourth place. He earned a series-high six podium finishes including wins at Auto Club Speedway and Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course.
