SUBJECT: 119,000 Model 20-EDL ball socket assemblies incorporated into ArvinMeritor axles manufactured from October 31, 1999, through May 31, 2000, and from June 12, 2000, through August 31, 2000. Also, 62,000 20-EDL aftermarket ball socket assemblies. Certain TRW tie rod ball-socket bearings have a below specification case depth and/or hardness which can lead to premature deterioration of the socket in some applications.

This is an <u>initial</u> acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be forthcoming shortly. After our review of your report and associated documents, we may have additional comments or concerns.
