

DESIGN FOR A MOTOR-CASING FOR VEHICLES.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 31,258, dated July 18, 1899.

Application filed June 20, 1899. Serial No. 721,246. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HERBERT W. ALDEN, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city of Hartford, county of Hartford, State of 5 Connecticut, have invented and produced a certain new and original Design for Motor-Casings for Vehicles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part hereof.

This invention relates to easings or covers for driving mechanism for motor-vehicles; and it consists in the design for such easings shown in the accompanying drawings, in

Figure 1 is a side view of a casing which embodies the design, and Fig. 2 is an end elevation thereof.

In accordance with the invention the de-

sign comprises a middle part A and two end portions B, which are relatively of reduced 20 cross-section as compared with the middle part A and near their extremities have extensions b b from the same side of the axis.

The characteristic feature of the design is the lateral extension b from each reduced por- 25 tion B near its extremity.

I claim as my invention—
