

DESIGN FOR AN UNDERSLUNG BATTERY-FRAME FOR VEHICLES.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 32,367, dated March 20,1900.

Application filed February 10, 1900. Serial No. 4,828. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HENRY SILL BALDWIN, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city and county of Hartford, in the State of Connecticut, have invented and produced a certain new and original Design for Underslung Battery-Frames for Vehicles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

This invention relates to the frames by which electric storage batteries are supported beneath the bodies of electric-motor vehicles; and it consists in the design for such a frame shown in the accompanying drawing, which represents in perspective, as seen from a point at one side of and slightly below the frame, a frame which embodies the design.

In accordance with this design each light

skeleton-like side appears to depend from the vehicle-body, comprising a rear member a, substantially vertical, a front member b, having the forwardly and rearwardly extending curved branches c and d, and the horizontal member e. The unity of the design is made 25 apparent by transverse horizontal members f, extending from one longitudinal member e to the other.

I claim as my invention-

The design for an underslung battery-frame 30 for a vehicle, substantially as shown and described.
