


*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, FABIO B. SERGARDI, a subject of the King of Italy, residing at Lansing, in the county of Ingham and State of Michigan, have invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for a Radiator-Frame, of which the following is a specification, reference being had therein to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a front elevation of a radiator frame, and Fig. 2 is a side elevation thereof.
